## Chestnut Gate Hurdles

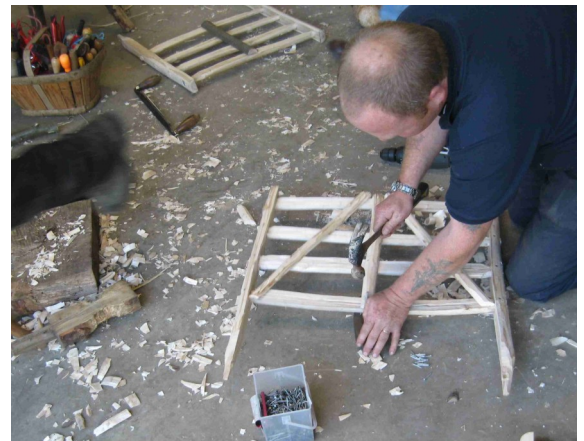
Learn how to make a chestnut gate hurdle for your garden, allotment, farm or woodland on a one day course organised by Woodnet and Plumpton College at Flimwell.

You will learn the skills of constructing chestnut gate hurdles by making a small hurdle to take home. You can then apply the techniques you have learned to construct your own gate hurdles of various sizes. Your tutor, Alan Sage, will guide you through the day, showing you how to select materials, cleave and shave the chestnut, and assemble the hurdle. This is a practical course using hand tools.
