Selecting and Milling Timber

This one day course, organised by Woodnet and Plumpton College at Flimwell, is aimed at those interested in learning how to select and prepare timber for sale or their own use. It will be useful for those managing trees and woodland and those wishing to select and use timber for construction, furniture making and other purposes.

You will learn the value and uses of the main timber trees, how to select the best trees for different uses and how to mill and store the timber. You will also learn how to market and sell the timber with guidance on pricing. The course will include how to set up and use a mobile saw mill and how to engage contractors.

The course, led by Tim Saunders of Rother Forestry, will comprise indoor presentation and discussion with outdoor sessions.
